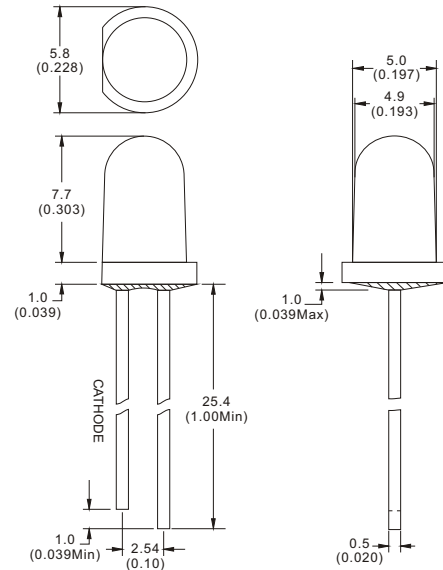

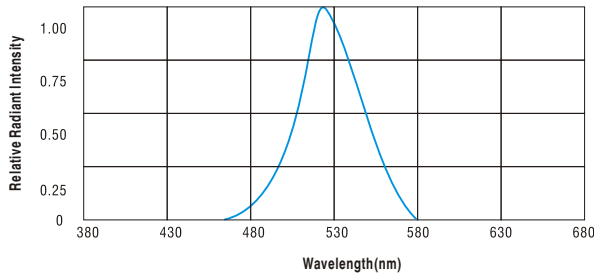

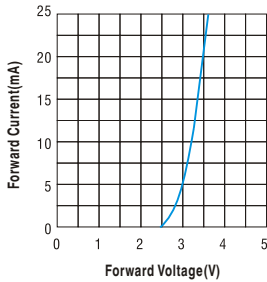

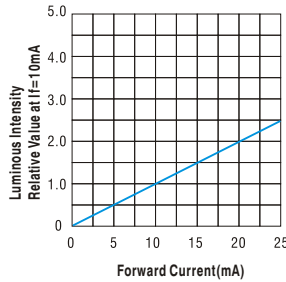
RELATIVE INTENSITY VS WAVELENGTH



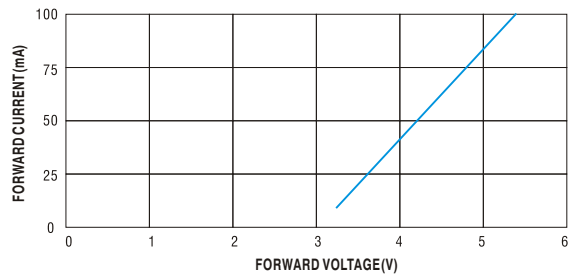
FORWARD CURRENT VS FORWARD VOLTAGE



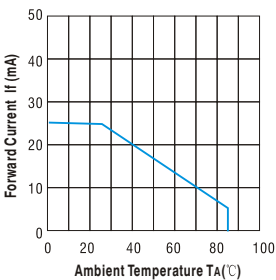
LUMINOUS INTENSITY VS FORWARD CURRENT



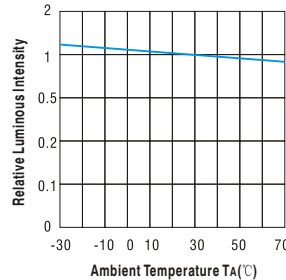
PEAK FORWARD VOLTAGE VS FORWARD CURRENT (100μS TEST PULSE, 1% DUTY CYCLE)
