- When using switching mode power supply to supply the power, ground F.G. terminal and connect a condenser between 0 V and F.G. terminal to remove noise.
- When connecting a DC relay or other inductive load, remove surge by using diodes or varistors.
- Wire as short as possible and keep away from high voltage lines or power lines, to prevent surge and inductive noise.

QSA series photoelectric protection devices use mirrors to change the transmission direction of light to form 2-sided, 3-sided or 4-sided protection areas.

Detection distance optional: A:0.3-3m,B:0.3-6m,C:0.3-10m,D:0.3-15m,E:0.3-20m,F:0.3-25m,G:0.3-30m,H:0.3-45m.

Installation instructions

Before installation, please open the packing box first, check the packed components according to the packing list.

- 1、Installation direction
- 1.1The emitter is equipped with a visible laser assisted positioning indicator.



1.2 The installation direction of the transmitter and receiver should follow the required alignment.



Protection distance Max. ≤45m ① The emitter and receiver are in a straight horizontal line.



Protection distance Max. ≤20m ③ The emitter to the reflector and then to the receiver form a 90° right angle.



Protection distance Max. ≤30m

O The emitter to the reflector and then to the receiver form a 90° right angle.



Protection distance Max. ≤12m ④ The emitter to the reflector and then to the receiver form a 90° right angle.

1.3 If the protection distance cannot meet the needs, multiple sets of light curtain combinations can be selected.



Protection distance Max. ≤60m ⑤ It is composed of two sets of safety light curtains and reflectors.

- 1.2.Necessary tools:
- Allen key set
- Spirit level
- Hammer drill with 10mm concrete bit
- Hammer



- Align it and mark the bore holes.
- Drill the fixing holes according to instructions and insert the floor anchors.
- Set the columns up and screw them on firmly.
